Marina's design work has been featured at the Prague Quadrennial of Scenography (PQ) in 1987, 1995, 1999, 2003, 2007, 2011 and at WSD Gallery Exhibit – Toronto 2005.

As Chair of OISTAT Education Commission (2004-2012) Marina organized numerous design conferences and workshops jointly with design schools from across the world. Marina was strongly involved in the organization of Scenofest 2003, 2007.

In 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 in association with prof. Sun Daquing and Michael Ramsaur she organized the Beijing International Biennial of Stage Design Schools (BIB/ISDSWE) a students exhibit and workshop, joint project of OISTAT EduCom and the Central Academy for Drama, Beijing.

In 2013, at the congress in Cardiff, Marina was elected member of EC of OISTAT.
